What are the qualifications of applicants for the four-year bachelor's degree program at Central Police University?

What is the work or position for Central Police University graduates to be assigned after graduation?

- 1. Department of Public Security, Intelligence Affairs Division: Upon passing the Civil Service Special Examination for Intelligence Personnel, they will be appointed by the National Security Bureau.
- 2. Department of Marine Police: Upon passing the Civil Service Special Examination

for Marine Police, they will be appointed by the Ocean Affairs Council.

- 3. Department of Fire Science: After passing the Civil Service Special Examination for Fire Safety Police, they will be appointed by the Ministry of the Interior to the fire department.
- 4. Department of Crime Prevention and Corrections, Correctional Division: Upon passing the Civil Service Special Examination for Judicial Personnel, they will be appointed by the Ministry of Justice in accordance with relevant regulations.
- 5. Department of Border Police, Immigration Affairs Division: After passing the Civil Service Special Examination for Immigration Personnel, they will be appointed by the Ministry of the Interior to the immigration agencies.
- 6. Other departments: After passing the Civil Service Special Examination for Police, appointments are made by the Ministry of the Interior in accordance with relevant regulations.
